FEFCO Standards for Converting Equipment Technical Specifications for Equipment and processes

The standards support all those involved in the defining and checking of conversion equipment performance from pre-feeder to stacker. This includes printing, die-cutting, folding, gluing, breaking, stacking and bundling. Using these standards will ultimately

result in a win/win situation throughout the whole supply chain. Machines will be delivered ready to run and the converter will have a better understanding of what his/her equipment can

All Technical Seminar participants will receive a USB key containing the FEFCO conversion equipment standards workbook.

SAFETY HANDBOOK

Health & Safety is of the highest concern for FEFCO members. Smurfit Kappa Germany is offering all FEFCO members attending the Technical Seminar an English version of their Safety Handbook which describes in detail the work environment processes and responsibilities at plant level. Additional films showing case studies will also be available to FEFCO members.






